BVHC, along with 148 other health centers, was awarded the 2023 Gold Health Center Quality Leader badge by the Department of Health and Human Services. We couldn't be prouder of this accomplishment.

On February 27, 2014, BVHC opened its doors as Bennington County's first and only Federally Qualified Health Center with a mission of providing compassionate, responsive, comprehensive healthcare. With 7 employees, 9 volunteer board members, and 2,224 patients, the entire BVHC community embarked on a monumental journey that day.

We have spent the last 10 years striving to meet the healthcare needs of Bennington County and beyond, and we have grown! Today, BVHC provides primary care, general dentistry, and mental health and substance use counseling to over 4,000 patients who come to us from 108 towns in VT, MA, and NY. 
